Court Reporting 2 New and Renewal Applications

You will need all the documents and information below to apply for a court reporting license through the online Georgia Courts Registrar.

INDIVIDUAL REQUIREMENTS	
National Certification Examination from the NVRA or the NCRA (New Only)	 Pass the written knowledge and skill tests administered by one of the following national associations: National Verbatim Reporters Association (NVRA); or National Court Reporters Association (NCRA) American Association of Electronic Reporters and Transcribers (AAERT)
Affidavit of Lawful Presence	 New: Upload a signed and notarized affidavit Renewals: Non-US citizens must upload a signed, notarized affidavit annually
Secure and Verifiable Document	 New: Upload a copy of a secure and verifiable document that does not expire during the certification period Renewals: Non-US citizens must upload a copy of their secure and verifiable document annually View a list of acceptable documents
Board of Court Reporting Georgia Test (New Only)	Pass the Georgia test with a score of 80% or higher
LEAP Seminar (New Only)	Attend the first Learning Essentials about Professionalism (LEAP) Seminar authorized by the Board after certification.
Continuing Education (Renewals Only)	 Obtain ten hours of approved continuing education per calendar year Any reporter issued an initial certificate is not required to obtain credit hours for that calendar year.
Payment	• \$125 (credit card or check); \$200 for renewals who pay after April 1

Applicants that have been revoked by the Board of Court Reporting must reapply as a new court reporter and pay an additional \$500 fee.

Secure and Verifiable Document	 New: Upload a copy of a secure and verifiable document that does not expire during the certification period Renewal: Non-US citizen owners must upload a copy of their secure and verifiable document annually View a list of acceptable documents
Affidavit	 New: Upload a signed and notarized affidavit for the owner Renewal: Non-US citizen owners must upload a signed, notarized affidavit annually
Payment	• \$200 (credit card or check); \$250 for renewals that pay after April 1
